I was 7 miles close to the crater and the sky was clear. I heard a big boom and then a jet-like noise. Hot lava rockfalls flyed away; from the ashcloud merged one lightning created by ash particles friction. It was a glorious moment, not a composite. Technically, capturing volcano eruptions with 3" shutter speed is very risky.
